The Hingham Historical Society was established in 1914 to collect, preserve, and exhibit Hingham's historic heritage. The Society maintains the 1688 Old Ordinary, an enchanting house museum chronicling early life and history in Hingham, and the 1818 Old Derby Academy building, home of the original Derby School, the oldest co-educational day school in the country. Scrupulously maintained through the years, Old Derby now houses the Society's gift shop, archives and visitor center. Our community programs include museum tours, an annual tour of historic homes, vintage baseball games, exhibits, lectures and other special events. We also present annual special achievement awards for high school students, and to individuals who achieve distinction in the preservation and restoration of historic buildings in Hingham.
