

The F.R. and L.L. Hart Collection 2012.32

Abstract

This collection contains 18 archival boxes (12 cu. ft.) of notes, correspondence, manuscripts and other materials collected by the authors of the 1993 Hingham town history book, *Not All Is Changed: A Life History of Hingham*, Francis Russell Hart and Lorena Laing Hart. The materials were produced between 1987 and 2002, but contain research documenting the history of the town of Hingham since its founding in 1635 as well as additional materials produced after the book was published. The collection was donated on behalf of the Harts by their son, Russell Hart, in 2012.

Collection Overview

Francis Russell Hart and Lorena Laing Hart were the authors of *Not All Is Changed: A Life History of Hingham*, an updated town history book published in 1993. The Harts were chosen by the town in 1987 to update the town's official history, last written in 1893. Both of the Harts were long-time biographical and historical researchers who had lived in Hingham since 1972 and undertook the six-year writing project both as historians and curious residents as to how the town of Hingham developed as it did. While the book focuses especially on the history of the town after the Civil War, it does contain an introductory section summarizing Hingham's first 230 years, especially pointed towards the origins of major themes of town geography, politics, and social interactions that are reflected throughout the town's history to the present day.

The collection consists of 18 archive boxes of research notes, correspondence, illustrations, phone logs, early book manuscripts, and other materials gathered while researching and writing *Not All Is Changed*. It also contains materials compiled by the Harts after the book was published until 2002, including summaries of town events and draft manuscripts of novels and plays based on Hingham history.

Contents of the Collection

This collection consists of the following series:

- I. **Research Notes**-Boxes 'HC 1' to 'HC 9'. Notes taken by the authors summarizing materials in history books, local newspapers, oral interviews, and town records used for writing 1993 history book. Folders are in chronological order based on historic dates, reflecting book chapters.
- II. **Correspondence**-Boxes 'HC 10' to 'HC 12'. Consists of letters to the authors and draft letters and copies of letters sent by the authors themselves. Most of the subjects revolve around historical research but some details problems that cropped up during the research and writing process. Folders are in chronological order.
- III. **Manuscripts**-Boxes 'HC 13' to 'HC 15'. This series includes final drafts of the *Not All Is Changed* book written between 1988 and 1993. It includes typed drafts, edited final proofs, and text that did not make it into the final published version. Some material has been preserved for a limited time at request of the authors.
- IV. **Supporting Documents**-Boxes '16' and '17'. These include original materials, or copies of, used in researching or the designing of *Not All Is Changed*. Documents include transcripts of oral history interviews, booklets with church histories, completed 1988 town survey forms, author created town history timelines, records of phone conversations and work hours, and copies of possible dust jackets and cover illustrations and book logo. Folders are in chronological order.
- V. **Post-Publication Materials**-Box '18'. Consists of many of the series noted above, but not used in the publishing of *Not All Is Changed*. Items include notes on Hingham events after book was published, various book and play manuscripts based on town history, and notes and manuscript for a possible book on Samuel Downer, all produced between 1994 and 2002. The Harts also left a 1.5 cu. ft. box of books used in their research, half of which were already in the Historical Society's collection. The rest were general American history volumes that were not catalogued into the Society's reference materials.
